- **Polls open 7:00 am - 7:00 pm**
- DO NOT attempt to drop your mail-in ballot at your precinct polling place on Election Day.
 - You can turn in mail-in ballots at any of the early voting locations during early voting days and hours or at the Voter Registration and Elections Office in Conway during open hours OR on Election Day.
 - You must have your photo ID. If someone else delivers your mail-in ballot for you, they must have an authorization form signed by you and their own photo ID.
